PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

High quality polyester putty reinforced with glass fiber designed for repairing cars. It is especially suitable for repairing large dents and holes in car bodies.

- Very good adhesion to metal.
- Excellent mechanical strength with proper flexibility.
- Short hardening time.
- Good sanding properties.

VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUNDS

VOC for the mixture = 30 [g/l]

This product meets the EU directive (2004/42/EC/II B) that sets the VOC value for its category (b), at 250 g/l.

SURFACE PREPARATION

The product has very good adhesion to various surfaces. It can be applied over:

- Bare steel and aluminum after flatting and degreasing.
- Zinc coated steel after flatting and degreasing.
- Sanded glass fibre (GFK/GRP), polyester putties, acrylic and epoxy primers, existing coatings in good condition.

We recommend sandpaper with gradations: P80÷P120.

Caution: Do not apply the putty directly on the reactive primers, 1K acrylic and nitrocellulose products.

APPLICATION PROCESS USE **NUMBER OF LAYERS** Putty can be applied in several thin coats. After each of them Glass fibre reinforced polyester putty for fast car the product should be cured. Do not extend thickness of 5 repairs. It is recommended for filling large car body dents and holes. Pot life is 4÷6 minutes at 20°C. MIXING RATIO HARDENING TIME by weight 100 parts Putty 20÷25 minutes at 20°C. Hardener 2 parts Temperature below 20°C significantly increases the Stir thoroughly until achieving homogenous hardening time. paste. Be careful not to create air inclusions. SANDING IR DRYING Coarse sanding (dry): P80÷P150. It is not recommanded. Finishing sanding (dry): P150÷P240.

FURTHER WORK

Polyester putties can be over coated with:

- 2K polyester putties,
- 2K polyester spray fillers.

GENERAL NOTES

- Excessive amount of hardener will cause problems with bleaching of the topcoat!
- When working with 2K products, it is recommended to use personal protection equipment. Protect the eyes and respiratory system.
- The rooms should be well ventilated.
- Clean the guns and equipment immediately after use.

Caution: To maintain safety, always follow the instructions given in the MSDS for the products.



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STORAGE

Store the product components between 15 to 25°C in a sealed container, in dry and cool places, away from fire and heat sources, as well as direct sunlight.

Note:

- 1. Close the container after use.
- 2. Protect it from overheating!
