PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

High-quality 2K multifunctional urethane primer with the addition of anti-corrosion agents, intended for car repairs. Thanks to the use of advanced technology and high-class ingredients, DTM Primer Sealer has a very wide range of applications. It works perfectly both as a filling undercoat and an insulating primer. It can be applied directly to metal, providing excellent corrosion protection for areas ground to bare steel. It insulates very well difficult substrates and putty areas from varnish coatings, protecting them against the effect of the so-called mapping. An additional advantage of the primer is the possibility of applying the "wet on wet" technique, without the need for sanding.

The undercoat is available in 3 colours: grey, white and black. Mixing the available colors in the right proportions allows you to obtain 2 additional colors, which allows you to work in the full spectrum grey system and select the recommended base color for the target base color.

Benefits:

- Excellent anti-corrosion protection of steel.
- Strong adhesion to various types of surfaces.
- Very good insulating and filling properties.
- Very short curing time.
- Can be applied using the "wet on wet" technique.

VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUNDS

VOC for the mixture = 247.2 g/l - 2.063 lb/gal. (<2.1 lb/gal)

SURFACE PREPARATION

The multifunctional primer can be applied over:

- Bare steel and aluminum after matting and degreasing.
- Zinc coated, galvanized steel after matting and degreasing.
- Sanded polyester laminates (GFK/GRP).
- Wash primers.
- Polyester primers.
- Isolation primers.

USE

Old finishes in good condition after matting and degreasing.

Good surface preparation is necessary for achieving best results.

Following sandpaper gradations are recommended:

- sanding by hand (dry): P280÷P400; (wet) P400-P800.
- sanding by machine (dry): P240÷P400.

APPLICATION PROCESS



For car repairs as a grounding primer for sanding (filling or priming option) and for the application with so-called wet-on-wet technique.

Stir thoroughly until achieving homogenous mixture.



NUMBER OF COATS & SPRAY GUN SETTINGS

Sanding option: 1÷2 coats

- filling version about 80 μm (3.15 mil) per single dry coat.
- grounding version approx. 50 µm (1.97 mil) per single dry coat.

Spray gun parameters:

Compliant (RP) spray gun: 1.6÷2.0 mm; Pressure of

input: 29÷32 psi (2.0÷2.2 bar)

HVLP spray gun: 1.5÷1.7 mm; Inlet pressure: 26÷29 psi (1.8÷2.0 bar), Air cap pressure: 9÷10 psi (0.6÷0.7 bar).

Wet-on-wet option: 1.5 coats. approx. 30 µm (1.18

mil) per single dry coat. Spray gun parameters:

Compliant (RP) spray gun: 1.2÷1.4 mm; Pressure of

input: 29÷32 psi (2.0÷2.2 bar)

HVLP spray gun: 1.3÷1.5 mm; Inlet pressure: 26÷29 psi (1.8÷2.0 bar), Air cap pressure: 9÷10 psi (0.6÷0.7 bar).



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SPRAYING VISCOSITY



Filling option (at 5÷10% reducer): 40÷30 sec at 20°C (68°F)/DIN4

Grounding option (at 15÷20% reducer): 25÷20 sec at 20°C (68°F)/DIN4

Wet-on-wet option (at 25÷30% reducer): 19÷17 sec at 20°C (68°F)/DIN4



POT LIFE

Filling option: approx. 45 minutes at 20°C (68°F) Grounding option: approx. 45 minutes at 20°C (68°F) Wet-on-wet option: approx. 1,5h at 20°C (68°F)




EVAPORATION TIME Between coats: 5÷10 minutes

Before applying solvent base: approx. 20 minutes Before applying water base: approx. 30 minutes Evaporating time depends on temperature and coat thickness.



DRY SANDING



Wet-on-wet doesn't require sanding!



WET SANDING

Machine sanding: P600÷P1000. Hand sanding:: P800÷P1000.

Wet-on-wet doesn't require sanding!



Hardening time at 20°C (68°F):

- Grounding version (50 \div 100 μ m): ready for sanding after 1h.
- Filling version (80 \div 160 μ m): ready for sanding after 2h.

Temperature below 20°C (68°F) significantly increases the hardening time.



IR DRYING

Grounding version 50–100 μ m (2.0–3.9 mil) dry film thickness: 6÷8 minutes under short waves. Filling version 80–160 μ m (3.1–6.3 mil) dry film thickness: 8÷10 minutes under short waves.

Do not exceed 60°C (140°F)

Use as recommended by the equipment manufacturer. Wait about 10 minutes before starting the heater

drying.

FURTHER WORK

2K urethane fillers can be directly over coated with:

- 2-pack urethane topcoats.
- 1-pack basecoats..

Also:

- 2K polyester body fillers / putties.
- 2K urethane primers.

GENERAL NOTES

- Do not exceed recommended doses of the hardener!
- The best repair results can be achieved at room temperature. The temperature in the body shop and the temperature of the product should be similar.
- When working with 2K products, it is recommended to use personal protection equipment. Protect the eyes and respiratory
- The rooms should be well ventilated.
- Clean the guns and equipment immediately after use.

Caution: To maintain safety, always follow the instructions given in the MSDS for the products.

Store the product components between 15 to 25°C (59 to 77°F), in a sealed container, in dry and cool places, away from fire and heat sources, as well as direct sunlight.

Note:

- 1. After each use the container with product should be immediately closed!
- 2. Protect the hardener from frost and dampness!
